### **Feast Days this Week**

**Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> June: St Barnabas the Apostle** was born in Cyprus. He was one of the early converts in Jerusalem and vouched for St Paul when he appeared before the elders there. He accompanied Paul on his first missionary journey and later went to Cyprus with his cousin John Mark (Mark the evangelist) to preach the gospel there. He was probably martyred at Salamis in Cyprus, some time before the year 61.

**Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> June: BI Alphonsus Mazurek and Companions** Alphonsus was born in 1891 at Baranowka, near Lubartow, Poland. He entered the Order of Discalced Carmelites in 1908, taking the religious name Alphonsus Mary of the Holy Spirit. He was ordained a priest and appointed as a professor, while dedicating himself to the education of youth. Afterwards he served in his Order as prior and bursar. In 1944, after having been arrested by the German troops that had invaded his country, he was shot on 28th August at Nawojowa Gora, near Krzeszowice. He was beatified by John Paul II on 13th June 1999, together with many other Polish martyrs.

**Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June: St Davnet** lived and died at Tydavnet, Slieve Beagh, Co. Monaghan. Tradition states St Davnet founded a church or monastery. A bachall (staff) said to have been hers has been preserved and in the past it was used as a test of truth.

**Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> June: BI Peter Snow & Ralph Grimston** Peter Snow (c. 1567-1598) was born at or near Ripon and arrived at the English College, Reims in 1589. He was ordained priest two years later in Soissons, France and left for the English mission, five years before the end of the reign of Elizabeth I. Snow was arrested in May 1598, when on his way to York. His companion on this journey was Ralph Grimston (?-1598) of Nidd, near Ripley in North Yorkshire. Grimston was a married layman who had previously suffered imprisonment for opening his house to Catholic priests and was arrested for trying to prevent Peter Snow being taken. They were quickly tried. Peter Snow was convicted of treason as a Catholic priest and was condemned to being hanged, drawn and quartered. Ralph Grimston was convicted of felony, for having aided and assisted Snow, and was condemned to death by hanging. Both suffered at York. They were beatified in 1987. Their skulls were for many years in the Catholic chapel at Hazlewood Castle and were placed in the main altar at St Anne's Cathedral, Leeds on 13 November 2006 when this new altar was consecrated.
